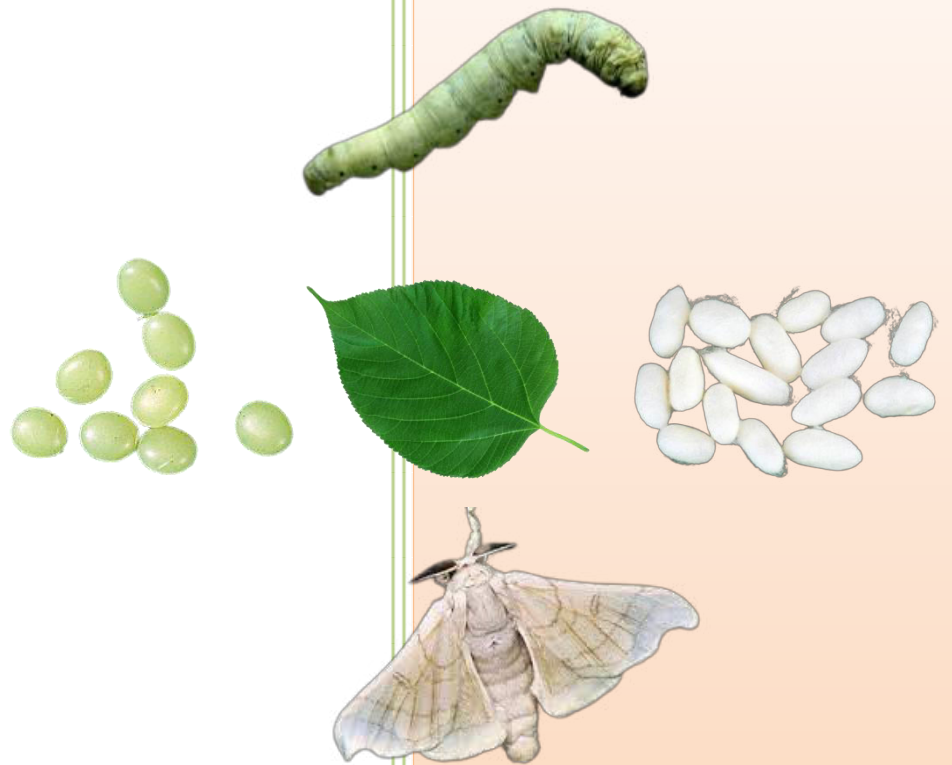



Short Report (in English)	Under the guidance of Dr. S. D. Umdale and Dr. S. R. Patil, Department of Botany and Department of Zoology arranged 2 days study tour to Chiplun, Harne and Dapoli on 21 st and 22 nd February 2024
Outcome/Remark	This study tour has delivered lot of knowledge regarding marine biodiversity, wildlife and ecology. Students have created a bonding between nature and students.



Introduction:

As per syllabus, Department of Zoology has arranged study tour of B. Sc. II to visit Chiplun, Harne Bandar and Dapoli. The main motive behind this tour was to explore animals in their natural habitat. The study tour was headed by Dr. S. R. Patil, and Miss. A. B. Dhandale. As per the plan tour was arranged on 21st and 22nd February 2024. This study tour was sponsored by DBT Star College Scheme. We all gathered at Jaysingpur bus stand on 21st February 2024 at 5.30 AM and departure the Jaysingpur exactly at 06:10 AM. After travelling about 6 hours we reached Chiplun which was our first destination.

Here our plan was to visit D. B. J. College. Exactly at 12.30 PM we entered in Department of Zoology, D. B. J. College. In this department Dr. Babar sir introduced their faculty members and also given introduction to the museum. In this museum stuffed animals were arranged in systematic manner. Some of the animals were also preserved in formalin. Animals from this museum were collected and maintained since 1964.

In this museum we experience a marvelous feel by observing all types of animals including insects, reptile, birds and mammals. Birds like Steppe eagle, Bonelli's eagle, vulture, owl, Sea gull, sparrow, woodpecker, kingfisher, duck, sunbird, parrot, peacock, pigeon etc were stuffed. However reptiles like monitor lizard, various species of snakes like Russel's viper, Indian cobra, pit viper, hump nosed viper, green pit viper, bamboo pit viper, rat snake, coral snake, checkered keelback were also preserved. Mammals like Asian palm civet, Pangolin, Ruddy mongoose, Squirrel, loris, leopard (including embryos), Rabbit, wild cat, fox etc were stuffed scientifically.

In the second section of this museum contains various economically important insects. In this section specimen of honey bee, butterflies, moths, beetles, wasps, mantis, grasshoppers, weevils, Jassids, aphids, May flies were maintained properly. The motive behind this visit was to know the scientific way of stuffing called Phylotaxy.

Finally Babar sir delivered a talk on scope and departmental activities run over there. We had a group photo with faculty members of that department. We departed from chiplun and headed towards Harne Bandhar.

Harne Bandar is 14 Km from Dapoli. We reached there at 05:00 PM. We visited Harne bandhar where a huge fish market is situated. Various types of fishes like Surmai, Pomphret, Bombay duck, shark, Bangda were marketed. On the same way various types of prawns, crabs, were also auctioned over here. Miss. A. B. Dhandale gave the detailed information of that fishes. The daily turnover of this bandhar is about 4-5 crore rupees. At the end of the day we stayed at the guest house of Dr. Sawant Krishi Vidhyapeeth (Kisan bhavan), Dapoli.

On the next morning we visited Dr. Balasaheb Sawant konkan Krishi Vidhyapeeth, formerly Konkan Krishi Vidyapeeth, is agricultural university at Dapoli in Ratnagiri district of Maharashtra, India. It was established on 18th May 1972 as Konkan Krishi Vidyapeeth, and got its present name on 12th February 2001. In this university we visited various departments. Firstly we visited medicinal garden where various plant species and their uses in medical field was noted. In the same place nursery of medicinal plant is also situated.

Next to medicinal plants garden we visited Charak udyan. The concept of charak udyan is that on a single disease various plant parts would be used as medicine. In this charak udyan we observed various plant species and their respective healing diseases. In the same udyan we also observed a nest of paper wasp, bag worm and various birds Paper wasp is also a social animal in which the work is distributed among the casts.

We also we visited Forestry Department where, we have gone through butterfly garden, Bamboo plantation, Bamboo Workshop.

After this informative visit, we started our journey back at 2:30 PM. Finally we were back to Jaysingpur at 11:00 PM on 22nd February 2024. This zoological excursion was fruitful. We enjoyed this tour and also knew many animals in the nature.
